The Club was established in 1981 to provide an opportunity for local children to play football and receive coaching in a safe and enjoyable environment. The grant was to support the cost of replacing ageing mini-soccer goals with FA approved inflatable goals from Redyset used by children from ages 6 to 10.

The Club has recently received the FA Charter standard.

The Forum was founded in 1998 and the main purpose is to address issues that local young people (ages 11-19) face and provide opportunities for social and personal development through a range of informal learning experiences in an environment that is both safe and enjoyable. They also provide support and help for vulnerable and disadvantaged young people. The forum enables young people to take ownership of and make decisions about their projects and programmes. With the support of qualified Youth Workers they can achieve accredited outcomes. The grant was to support the upgrading of the Forum's portacabin style building. Wear and tear and a break-in had meant there was a need to upgrade the intruder alarm, secure doors and windows and replace some of the rotted wooden exterior, including an access ramp and some steps.

Donors' Rights Charter
